STATE'S NOTICE OF GIGLIO DISCLOSURE

The State of New Mexico, by and through Deputy District Attorney Rachel Eagle, hereby gives notice to the Court and the Defendant that it has found that potential impeachment information exists for Officer Fouad Cherair, formerly with the Albuquerque Police Department, and that the State has disclosed the information to the defense as required by *Giglio v. United States*, 405 U.S. 150 (1972), Rule 5-501(A)(6) NMRA, Rule 5-505 NMRA, and LR2-308(C) NMRA. The State's disclosure obligations are not limited by the evidence that would be admissible at trial. Rule 5-503(C) NMRA. By making this disclosure, the State takes no position on the admissibility of such information as evidence or the use of such information in cross-examination and reserves the right to object to the introduction at trial of any evidence that should be excluded under the Rules of Evidence.
